Application requirements:

- Minimum KCSE mean grade of B (plain)
- Strong grades on major subjects that are key to specialty preferred
- An authenticated copy (by Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Foreign and Diaspora Affairs and legalized translation (French or Arabic) of the High School certificate- **academic year 2022 only**
- An authenticated copy (by Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Foreign and Diaspora Affairs and legalized translation (French or Arabic) of the High School certificate transcript
- Have an original KCSE Certificate
- A legalized Copy of birth certificate or any other document in lieu thereof such as National Identity card.
- A copy of passport- **in case the passport is not ready; the candidate has to enclose a copy of the payment receipt for the passport application pending the submission of the authenticated copy of the passport once ready.**
- Four (04) recent passport photos
- Medical certificate that attests to the absence of infectious and or contagious diseases and that the candidate is able to follow his or her course that will be provided to him/her, as well as a medical tests report.

The scholarships offered by the Algerian Government are partly funded and cover the following:

- Inscription fees: the students will only pay a symbolic fee applied to the Algerian students
- Accommodation in university hostels
- Meals at university restaurants
- University bus transportation
- Access to the public health system on modalities applied to Algerian students
- Quarterly allowance
- One year of language training in French or Arabic languages
