**2025/2026 SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY IN CYPRUS  
Postgraduate (MSc) Scholarships at the Cyprus Institute of Neurology and  
Genetics (CING)**

The Ministry is pleased to announce the availability of postgraduate scholarship opportunities for Kenyan nationals for the 2025/2026 academic year, as communicated by the High Commission of the Republic of Cyprus in Nairobi. This follows a Memorandum of Cooperation signed between the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Cyprus and the Cyprus Institute of Neurology and Genetics (CING).

Under this agreement, up to three (3) scholarships will be offered to qualified Kenyan applicants wishing to pursue MSc studies at CING.

**Scholarship Coverage:**

- **Full Tuition Fees:** The scholarship covers full tuition fees amounting to €8,000.
- **Monthly Stipend:** A monthly stipend of up to €1,000 will be provided for a duration of twelve (12) months to support accommodation and living expenses in Cyprus.

**Eligibility and Selection Criteria:**

- Applicants must be Kenyan nationals.
- Scholarships will be awarded based on academic merit and fulfillment of CING's entry requirements.
- All candidates will be evaluated by CING, and successful applicants will be informed upon admission.

**Application Deadline:**

The deadline for international (non-EU) applications is **14th May 2025**.
