MOROCCAN AGENCY FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION (AMCI) SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2025/2026

The Ministry is in receipt of communication from the Kenyan Mission in Rabat, Morocco that Moroccan Agency for International Cooperation offering Government of the Republic of Kenya **Twenty (20) scholarships slots for the 2024/2025 Academic Year.**

Candidates admitted to scientific, technical and economic field studies should note that the said areas are taught in French. Candidates who do not speak French will be required to take French language upgrade courses at the International Language Center in Rabat, affiliated to AMCI during the 2025/2026 academic years. The Arabic Language and Literature and Islamic Studies courses are taught in Arabic. Candidates for these courses must master this language. The Legal Science course is taught in both Arabic and French.

Interested candidates should have;

Undergraduate

- i. Minimum of KCSE Mean grade of B Plain
- ii. Age limit for the candidates varies depending on the institution between 19 and 23 years.
- iii. Stronger grades in major subjects that are key to area of preferred studies.
- iv. Completed Secondary education in the last three years
- v. Have KCSE original certificate.

Masters

- i. Not more than 35 years old
- ii. Hold at least 2nd class Honours Upper Division Degree

PhD

- i. Not more than 45 years old
- ii. Hold a relevant Master's degree from a recognized University.

Postgraduate students should note that mastery of French is a requirement and they need to specify the course and university they intend to study from. To this

end they are requested to visit the website of the Department of Higher Education at www.enssup.gov.ma as well those of Morocco universities.

Document to be submitted with the AMCI application form in duplicate include;

- i. the STANDARD SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM from the Ministry of Education Website: <http://www.education.go.ke/>.
- ii. For undergraduate studies certified copies of KCSE Certificate and for postgraduate studies certified copies of university degree, transcripts of the same. Doctoral students submit the thesis/dissertation prepared for obtaining masters degree and the doctoral project.
- iii. Certified copies of the birth certificate and passport
- iv. Certificate of good conduct.
- v. A medical certificate issued by a public health services attesting to the physical fitness of the candidate and certifying one is vaccinated.
