COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT: FUTURE SKILLS, AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND
AWARDS MASTERS SCHOLARSHIPS

The Future Skills in Auckland, New Zealand in partnership with the Kenya High Commission, Canberra has offered two (2) Masters Scholarships; **Master of Applied Management – Business Management** and **Master of Applied Management – Business Information System** for study in Auckland. Each scholarship covers the first twelve (12) months of an eighteen (18) month program. The waived tuition fees for both is \$27,000. Scholarship recipients will be required to pay \$13,500 for the final six (6) months.

The announcement requires that applicants must:

- a. Hold a Kenyan passport and reside in Kenya at the time of the application
- b. Be aged between 18 and 35 years
- c. Be ready to commence study in April, 2026 (deferrals may be considered for visa delays)
- d. Meet all entry requirements
 - i. A Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) in a related discipline with a grade average of Level 7/8 of B- or higher
 - ii. Provide Academic IELTS 6.5 (with no band lower than 6.0, achieved in a single test within the last two years), OR Acceptable alternative evidence of English proficiency (see NZQA proficiency table)
 - iii. Receive an unconditional offer letter by Friday 5th December, 2025
- e. Submit all required documents, including academic record, CV, English proficiency test results, and passport

Students are responsible for other costs, including insurance. Immigration New Zealand requires proof of funds: at least \$20,000 per year of study for living costs.

The applications are open from **30th October to 1st December, 2025**.
