COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT: COMMISSION ON SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT IN THE SOUTH (COMSATS) SCHOLARSHIPS

The Kenya High Commission of Islamabad has been allocated scholarships for Masters and PhD programs at COMSATS, specifically for eligible students and researchers from Kenya.

The Commission on Science and Technology for Sustainable Development in the South (COMSATS) offers Graduate (MS and PhD) Scholarships to its Member States and partner countries, at the **COMSATS University, Pakistan**, which is one of the 25 Centres of Excellence of COMSATS. COMSATS will select **two candidates** for the scholarship.

These scholarships are offered in the following key programs:

- **Master's Degree (MS) Programs:** Bioinformatics, Biotechnology, Computer Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Energy Systems Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Cyber Security, Artificial Intelligence, Environmental Sciences, and Remote Sensing & Geographic Information System.
- **PhD Programs:** Bioinformatics, Computer Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Biotechnology, Environmental Sciences, and Remote Sensing & GIS.

The scholarship covers Admission Fee, Registration Fee, Lab/Bench Fee and Tuition Fee. **However, the living and air travel expenses will be borne by the candidates.**

The broad eligibility criteria are as follows:

MS Program

- 16 years degree in the relevant field
- CGPA 2.5/4 (semester system) or not less than 60% in annual system
- No third division or Grade "D" (i.e. less than 45% marks) in academic career
- IELTS minimum 6.0 band or TOEFL Internet-based test - overall minimum score 70
- International students may appear in the departmental test during the first semester of their studies

PhD Program

- 18 years degree in the relevant field with thesis of 06 credit hours
- CGPA 3/4 (semester system) or not less than 70% in annual system.
- No third division or Grade "D" (i.e. less than 45% marks) in academic career
- IELTS minimum 6.0 band or TOEFL Internet-based test - overall minimum score 70
- International students may appear in the departmental test during the first semester of their studies.
